## Lary Barilleau Biography

I grew up in the Seattle music scene. My mother Vonne Griffin was inducted into the Earshot Jazz Hall of Fame. I am a graduate of Franklin High School and its famed jazz lab of the 1970's. I have been a professional musician in the Seattle music scene for over thirty years as a percussionist and composer in jazz, Latin jazz, contemporary jazz, folk and rhythm and blues. I have played over a thousand performances during that time including, Bumbershoot Festival, Bellevue Jazz Festival, Folklife Festival, Festival Sundiata, Boise Jazz Fest, Out To Lunch Series, Art of Jazz at Seattle Art Museum, King TV, KING FM, The Paramount Northwest Theatre, 5th Avenue Theatre, Meany Theatre and dozens of clubs including The Jazz Alley, Triple Door and Tula's Jazz Club. This includes countless benefit performances for Seattle Schools, Seattle Children's Hospital and fundraisers as well. I co-founded the popular Latin-jazz group Sonando and have worked extensively with faculty from Cornish School of the Allied Arts and the University of Washington such as Julian Prestier, Chuck Deardorf, James Knapp and for over fifteen years in Marc Seales Jazz Group. I also held a position the Experience Music Project's music advisory board.

I have been a certificated teacher in the Seattle Public Schools for fifteen years including three years teaching in Palm Springs, CA. I was also an assistant for over five years teaching disadvantaged youth in south Seattle through the Title One Program. I have taught kindergarten through eighth grade where my specialty has been cultural arts and music. I am currently the head of International Arts at Hamilton International Middle School where I oversee a department of four teachers in performance art, visual art, and instrumental music. I have held this position for six years. I hold degrees from the University of Washington and Western Washington University.
