**Legislation Title:**

AN ORDINANCE relating to Seattle Municipal Code Section 22.502.016 and amending Sections 110, 205, 225, 604, 1603, 1604 and 1702 of the 2012 Seattle Plumbing Code, to clarify regulations and adopt amendments consistent with the Washington State Plumbing Code.

**Summary of the Legislation:** This legislation clarifies the procedure for review of DPD decisions about permit applications. It adopts amendments recently added to the State Plumbing Code regarding lead content in potable water piping, and cross-connection control for recycle water systems.

**Background:** The Seattle Plumbing Code is one of several construction-related codes that local jurisdictions are required to enforce. New editions of these codes are adopted by the State every 3 years; Seattle adds local amendments to the State codes. Seattle adopted the 2012 codes in 2013.

This legislation is one of seven related bills that amend the construction-related codes to adopt recent state code provisions and correct errors.
