ORDINANCE 103570

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Civil Service Department; fixing compensation for the Civil Service Commissioners and providing payment therefor, and superseding Ordinance 102480 to the extent inconsistent herewith.

WHEREAS, at the time of preparation and adoption of the 1974 Budget it was the intent of the City Council and so understood by incumbents in the office of Civil Service Commissioner that there be provided increased compensation for such offices as of January 1, 1974; and for such purpose additional salary funds were included in the 1974 Budget of the Civil Service Department; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Acting Personnel Director have recommended (C.F. 278596) that compensation for the office of Civil Service Commissioner be increased to \$200 per month; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as of January 1, 1974 the rate of compensation for the office of Civil Service Commissioner is hereby fixed at Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) per month, which increased compensation shall be paid from unexpended and unencumbered salary funds accumulating in the 1974 Budget of the Civil Service Department, all as recommended in C.F. 278596.

Section 2. That Ordinance 102480, entitled,


"AN ORDINANCE fixing the compensation of the officers and employees of the various departments of the City government of Seattle, subject to federal wage and salary restrictions, and superseding all ordinances insofar as in conflict.",

is hereby superseded to the extent inconsistent herewith.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.




