ORDINANCE 108126

AN ORDINANCE transferring the use of certain City Engineerin' Department property in Block 45, Homecroft Addition from general corporate purposes to street purposes and laying off 18th Avenue Southwest.

WHEREAS, said property was acquired pursuant to Ordinance 89984 for the Sound Way project with an appropriation from the City Street Fund, and

WHEREAS, said property was accepted by Ordinance 91075 for general corporate purposes and placed under the jurisdiction of the City Engineer, and

WHEREAS, the use of said property is to now be for street purposes, Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the use of certain City Engineering Department property be transferred from general corporate purposes to street purposes, said real property situate in Seattle, King County, Washington, to wit:

The easterly 10 feet of Lot 6 and the easterly 10 feet of Lot 8, EXCEPT the south 72.28 feet of said Lot 8, both in Block 45, Homecroft Addition, according to plat thereof recorded in Volume 24 of Plats, page 42, records of King County, Washington.

Section 2. That 18th Avenue Southwest be and the same is hereby laid off, opened, widened, extended and established over, through, across and upon the real property described in Section 1 hereof.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
