AN ORDINANCE accepting a deed for sanitary sewer purposes over portions of Pettit's Lake Washington Acre Tracts. (Kenmore Interceptor Sanitary Sewer Project)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the deed executed by King County, on August 6, 1980, conveying to the City of Seattle the following described real property situated in Seattle, King County, Washington, to wit:

The south two feet and shorelands adjacent to Lot D, Block 61, Pettit's Lake Washington Acre Tracts, according to the plat recorded in Volume 11 of Plats, Page 99, in King County, Washington;

(King County Recording No. 8103170570; R/W No. 7767-25)

be and the same is hereby accepted for sanitary sewer purposes.

(Kenmore Interceptor Sanitary Sewer Project)

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section ...2.. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.




The County felt they would rather pass a deed of above described property than have it encumbered by an easement.

The property was acquired for \$150 as authorized by Ordinance 109606.


