ORDINANCE 118533

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Office of Management and Planning (OMP), amending section 3.14.540 of the Seattle Municipal Code concerning the schedule for the City Council's adoption of OMP's annual work program.

WHEREAS, the Office of Management and Planning (OMP) was created in November 1994 via Ordinance 117408; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 117408, section 9 (part) enacted section 3.14.540 of the Seattle Municipal Code (SMC), which states the process by which the City Council will adopt OMP's annual work program; and

WHEREAS, the schedule provided in SMC 3.14.540 for adoption of OMP's work program is not realistic; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3.14.540 of the Seattle Municipal Code, which was enacted by Ordinance 117408, is amended to read as follows:

3.14.540 Work program to be adopted by City Council.

The annual work program for the office of Management and Planning, showing anticipated tasks/projects, likely work products, and approximate assignments of FTES, shall be set by the City Council. The Council's review of the work program shall be in two (2) steps:

A. The Director of the Office of Management and Planning shall submit a preliminary proposed work program for the following year to the City Council no later than October 1st for use during budget review.

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B. By January 15 of the following year, the Director of the Office of Management and Planning shall submit a revised proposed work program to the City Council. ((In January,))
During the first quarter, the City Council shall adopt a resolution setting the final work program for the Office of Management and Planning. This resolution shall guide the work of the Office throughout the year, and any significant changes to the work program shall require Council approval.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

ORDINANCE 118533

WHEREAS, the Office of Management and Planning (OMP) was created in November 1994 via Ordinance 117408; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 117408, section 3 (part) enacted section 3.14.540 of the Seattle Municipal Code (SMC), which states the process by which the City Council will adopt OMP's annual work program; and

WHEREAS, the schedule provided in SMC 3.14.540 for adoption of OMP's work program is not realistic; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 3.14.540 of the Seattle Municipal Code, which was enacted by Ordinance 117408, is amended to read as follows:

3.14.540 WORK PROGRAM TO BE ADOPTED BY CITY COUNCIL.

The annual work program for the Office of Management and Planning, showing anticipated tasks/projects, likely work products, and approximate assignments of FTES, shall be set by the City Council. The Council's review of the work program shall be in two (2) steps:

A. The Director of the Office of Management and Planning shall submit a PRELIMINARY proposed work program for the following year to the City Council no later than October 1st for use during budget review.

B. BY JANUARY 15 OF THE FOLLOWING YEAR, THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND PLANNING SHALL SUBMIT A REVISED PROPOSED WORK PROGRAM TO THE CITY COUNCIL. (In January.) DURING THE FIRST QUARTER, the City Council shall adopt a resolution setting the final work program for the Office of Management and Planning. This resolution shall guide the work of the Office throughout the year, and any significant changes to the work program shall require Council approval.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04-020.
