COUNCIL BILL 118301

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4 AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the
5 payment thereof.

6 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**

7 Section 1. Payment of the sum of \$40,874,309.97 on Summit mechanical warrants
8 numbered 4002441100 – 4002443331 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E-
9 Payables of \$112,290.27 on Summit 9000018849 – 9000018916 and Electronic Financial
10 Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$66,894,099.03 are presented for ratification by the City
11 Council per Chapter RCW 42.24.180.

12 Section 2. Payment of the sum of \$39,049,281.67 on City General Salary Fund
13 mechanical warrants numbered 51223129 – 51223708 plus manual warrants, agencies
14 warrants, and direct deposits numbered 20001 – 31648 representing Gross Payrolls for
15 payroll ending date Dec. 30, 2014 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims
16 against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said
17 committee to the City Council Jan 8, 2015 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for
18 such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

19 Section 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of
20 this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

21 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval
22 by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after
23 presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.





ORDINANCE NO. 124684

AN ORDINANCE relating to the City's criminal code; amending and adding to various sections and subsections in Chapters 3.33, 12A.06, 12A.08, 12A.10, 12A.14, 12A.16, 12A.20, 12A.24, 12A.28, 16.20 and 16.64 and repealing sections 2.20.010 and 2.20.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

ORDINANCE NO. 124685

AN ORDINANCE relating to the implementation and operation of a new regional 800 MHz emergency public safety radio communication system; authorizing the Chief Technology Officer of the Department of Information Technology to execute for and on behalf of the City of Seattle an interlocal agreement between the City of Seattle, King County and the Cities of Auburn, Bellevue, Federal Way, Issaquah, Kent, Kirkland, Mercer Island, Redmond, Renton and Tukwila for the purpose of planning, financing, procuring and implementing a new 800 MHz emergency radio communication system to be funded through a separate King County property tax ballot measure; and ratifying and confirming prior acts.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the City's traffic code; amending various sections and subsections in and adding sections to Chapters 11.22, 11.31, 11.34, 11.56, 11.57, 11.64, 11.66 and 11.82 and repealing sections 11.66.060, 11.66.080 and 11.66.100 of the Seattle Municipal Code to conform with changes in state law.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the future operation of a new regional 800 MHz emergency public safety radio communication system; authorizing the Chief Technology Officer of the Department of Information Technology to execute for and on behalf of the City of Seattle a memorandum of agreement between the City of Seattle, King County and the Cities of Auburn, Bellevue, Federal Way, Issaquah, Kent, Kirkland, Mercer Island, Redmond, Renton and Tukwila for the purpose of establishing key terms for a future interlocal agreement to create a non profit corporation, as provided under RCW 39.34.030, to manage, operate, and maintain a future regional emergency radio communication system.
