BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE, THAT:


The Council Bills, Resolution, and Clerk Files, listed on Attachment A, are retired and removed from consideration by the Full Council or the assigned standing committee.
